A deposit of \$500.00 USD with your trip registration forms is preferred by: August 1st, 2011. Final payment is due: September 1st, 2011. Any cancellation made in writing between: August 1st, 2011 and September 1st, 2011 will result in a cancellation fee of \$500.00 USD. Any cancellation made between: September 1st, 2011 and the trip departure will result in a total loss of your \$500.00 USD deposit along with any non-refundable funds made to our suppliers in Greece. Any cancellation made: after the trip departs will result in total loss of trip funds. We reserve the right to cancel the trip if it is not meeting the trip minimum. Trip cancellation insurance is always recommended when making travel plans. Your deposit is what confirms your reservation.

All forms must be signed and received in the office before departure or you will not be able to travel with us. Please understand our insurance carrier requires this of us! Also, it is essential that you put your flight information on the trip application form so we know when your flight is arriving!

Arrival and Departures to Santorini, Greece!

You are responsible for your travel arrangements to Santorini. Ales in Custom Travel is happy to assist you with flights! You can ring him at 866-866-5566. Santorini is a small island and it is quite easy to get around as everyone speaks English. Please stay with your luggage at all times! Consider changing money at the Athens airport if you have time between flights. If not, you can do so on the island. Do not change money in the USA as you will not get as good of a rate.

Money

It is a good idea to have money changed in the airport. In general you will need about \$40.00 per day for lunch and dinner (if you like a glass of wine add in a bit more). Jewelry and art is *incredible* on the island so be prepared for the desire to purchase lovely things – but remember you are paying a ~40% premium unless the item is on sale due to the strength of the Euro. *Be sure to write down the numbers of your credit cards, and the phone numbers of how to contact the companies from Greece if you need to. Keep them separate from the actual cards.* In case you want to do a special trip on the side consider you might need an extra \$30 for the day (to visit Akrotiri or Thirassia for example)

We eat breakfast together in the morning at the hotel – but please note that at lunchtime we may go out, same with dinner (although you can cook and eat in your room as you will have a kitchen). If you need to eat or snack often, make sure you have power bars, nuts, trail mix or whatever you need to take care of your body! Please note the food is *very good* on the island. Most restaurants in town take credit cards but some only accept cash – so be prepared. Also note that purchasing water everyday is a necessity as their water may not work with your system.

Ground Transportation

Taxis are very abundant on the island plus they have a *great* public transportation system that is fun and easy. In case you want to go someplace special, Linda is happy to drive you if she is available to do so and not with the group.

If you are bringing your cell phone with you, make sure your carrier allows you to make calls in Greece - and know what they are going to charge you!
