# TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR: Sedona Spiritual Retreat: Embracing Oneness September 19th-24th, 2009 Led by Sheri Rosenthal, DPM www.journeysofthespirit.com

#### Included

Total costs for this journey are \$1559.00 double occupancy accommodations - 5 nights and 6 days. There are 5 nights at the Sedona Mago Retreat Center in Sedona, AZ. There are certain meals included in this journey and they are noted next to each day on the itinerary in parentheses (5 breakfasts, 2 lunches and 5 dinners are included). All tips for the guides and bell boys are included. All lectures and teachings from Sheri Rosenthal DPM, Shanti and their designated teachers are included. The supplement for a single room can be requested at \$350.00. A single may not be available less than 45 days before the departure. While we cannot guarantee that we can find you a roommate, we make every effort to do so. In the event we are unable to find a roommate for you, you will be required to pay the single supplement cost.

### Not-Included

We are not responsible for your round trip flight from your home to Phoenix, AZ. Also not included are: meals not indicated in the itinerary, items of a personal nature such as, gifts, souvenir shopping, laundry services, beverages, toll calls, excess baggage, medical costs, the costs of hospitalization and evacuation from remote areas, travel insurance and additional expenses arising from the delay or extension of a trip due to weather, political disputes, sickness, failure of transportation, or other causes beyond our control. Tips to the maids are not-included (we suggest leaving \$1.00 per day). Other non-included items would be: massage services, other activities and tours not-included in our package.

## **Payment**

A \$500.00 dollar deposit per person, which secures your place on the journey, is preferably due by July 1st, 2009. The remaining payment in full is due by August 1st, 2009. All payments are by Visa or MasterCard, PayPal, money order or cashier's check, made out to "Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc." Unfortunately, no personal checks can be accepted. All payments must be received in the office a minimum of one week before the date of trip departure. We cannot make exceptions to this policy.

#### Cancellation and Refunds

If cancellation occurs 60 or more days before departure there will be no loss of deposit. Any cancellation made in writing from: July 1st- August 1st will result in a cancellation fee of \$500.00. Any cancellation made after: August 1st up to the date of departure will result in total loss of deposit (\$500.00) plus any non-refundable deposits we have had to make to our suppliers. Trip cancellation insurance is recommended to cover such issues. We reserve the right to cancel the trip if it is not meeting the trip minimum. All cancellations must be made to Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc in writing. Any refund

requests must be made in <u>writing</u> to Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc within 30 days of the return date. Please send written requests to: 420 Dover Highlands Trail, Ellijay, Georgia 30540. We strongly recommend Travel Cancellation Insurance if there is any chance you may have to cancel for any reason at all.

Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc reserves the right to cancel any trip prior to departure for any reason whatsoever, including an insufficient number of participants or logistical problems (e.g. acts of God, war, strikes, etc.), which may impede trip operations. The refund of all payments as described in the paragraph below shall release Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc from any further liability. A trip cancellation due to insufficient numbers would normally occur at least a month prior to departure, unless acts of God, war, strikes or other events impede our departure causing large numbers of participants opt to cancel participation on the journey in the last days before departure.

There will be some free time in the afternoon for massages and/or experiencing one of the vortex's on the retreat land. In the evening we will meet again for sharing, discussion and class.

Day 4 (b/-/d)- In the morning we will have a get together for class, sharing, dreaming and meditation time. After lunch we will hike to the Shaman's Cave for a Fire and Pipe Ceremony. In the evening we'll share and have a fire ceremony.

Day 5 (b/l/d)- For our last day we will hike either Cathedral or Mexcal Mt with the Birthing Cave. The afternoon will have some free time and we will meet again for our last evening dinner and class.
