Included

The 2011 trip cost: \$2799.00 USD per person double occupancy. If you desire a single room, the cost is an additional: \$640.00 USD per person. If you are interested in staying in Santorini with Linda for 2 more days (until Oct 23rd), the cost would be \$395.00 USD per person double occupancy and the single supplement would be \$160.00 USD. Total costs include: accommodations double occupancy for 7 nights and 8 days unless you are staying the two extra nights.

A single may not be available less than 45 days before the departure. Breakfast meals will be included in Santorini. While we cannot guarantee that we can find you a roommate, we make every effort to do so. In the event we are unable to find a roommate for you, you will be required to pay the single supplement cost.

Not-Included

We are not responsible for your round trip flight from your home to Santorini, Greece. Also not-included are: your meals other than breakfast as indicated, items of a personal nature such as, gifts, souvenir shopping, bike rentals, laundry services, beverages, toll calls, excess baggage, medical costs, the costs of hospitalization and evacuation from remote areas, travel insurance and additional expenses arising from the delay or extension of a trip due to weather, political disputes, sickness, failure of transportation, or other causes beyond our control. Tips to the guides if any outside of those indicated, plus the maids (we recommend you leave \$1.00/day) not-included. Non-included lunches and dinners at some of the restaurants in Santorini will need to be paid for in cash so plan accordingly. Other non-included items would be: massage services, other activities and tours not-included in our package.

Payment

A deposit of \$500.00 USD with your trip registration forms is preferred by: August 1st, 2011. Final payment is due: September 1st, 2011. All payments are by Visa or MasterCard, money order or cashier's check, made out to "Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc." Unfortunately, no personal checks can be accepted. All payments must be received in the office a minimum of one week **before** the date of trip departure. We cannot make exceptions to this policy.

Cancellation and Refunds

Any cancellation made in writing between: August 1st, 2011 and September 1st, 2011 will result in a cancellation fee of \$500.00 USD. Any cancellation made between: September 1st, 2011 and the trip departure will result in a total loss of your \$500.00 USD deposit along with any non-refundable funds made to our suppliers in Greece. Any cancellation made: after the trip departs will result in total loss of trip funds. We reserve the right to cancel the trip if it is not meeting the trip minimum. All cancellations must be made to Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc in writing. Any refund requests must be made in writing to Sheri A. Rosenthal, DPM Inc within 30 days of the return date. Santorini is a small, circular group of volcanic islands located in the Aegean Sea, about 200 km south-east from the mainland of Greece. Santorini is also known by the name of the largest island in the archipelago, Thira or Thera and is the southernmost member of the Cyclades group of islands. **This stunningly beautiful island** was the site of one of the largest volcanic eruptions of the last several thousand years when it erupted cataclysmically about 3,500 years ago.

Although this retreat is 9 days and 8 nights you have the opportunity to extend your visit for two more days! Linda will not be giving classes per se, but she will be available to assist and guide you in your work.

Day 0 – Oct 13 (-/-/-) Athens Greece!

Fly to Athens and stay overnight and get ready for your flight to Santorini in the morning. If you like, you are welcome to arrive in Athens a few days earlier and explore the city before joining the group. Most international flights to Athens travel overnight. If you make sure you take an evening flight on you will arrive in the morning and be able to catch the noon flight to Santorini.

Day 1 – Oct 14 (b/-/-) Oia, Santorini

Linda will meet you at the airport in Santorini to take you to your fabulous villa overlooking the Caldera. Rest and settle in and in the evening: informal get together with group, we'll explore our retreat location, and have a workshop overview.

Day 2 – Oct 15 (b/-/-) Volcanic Passion!

Today we start our day by enjoying the beautiful view from our hotel looking out over the caldera.

During our visit, we will have the opportunity to explore different aspects of the island, from the ancient ruins of Akrotiri, to the beautiful black and red beaches and the wonderful food and people. Included in our journey is a wonderful cruise around the caldera to really enjoy the energy of this volcanic paradise.

Today we'll meet from: 9:00 – 10:00 AM: breakfast, 10:00 – 10:30 AM: gentle stretches, 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM: morning session – **Introduction and Initiation: The Gods and Goddesses Within! Getting in touch with the archetypal energies within us.**

We'll have an Opening Ritual/Meditation, Create an Altar & Set our Intention, & have a Materials Demonstration. Today's Assignment: Spontaneity – connecting with DIONYSUS and getting in touch with your “Dionysian” volcanic creative passion! Then from 1:30- 4:30 PM: Vision Quest, lunch & rest. From 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM: Evening Session and at 6:30 PM: enjoy the beautiful Sunset and Dinner. Linda is available everyday from 1:30 – 2:30 PM for private consultation, art/tarot readings, channeling or shamanic guidance. There will be a Dream Assignment for tonight.

Day 3 – Oct 16 (b/-/-) Water: the Aegean Sea

Start today at 9:00 – 10:00 AM: Breakfast, then 10:00 – 10:30 AM: Tai Chi, and from 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM: morning session – Persephone, The Maiden and the Guide To The Unconscious Creativity Through Dreams. We'll have a Watercolor demonstration and Assignment: Paint your dream. Then from 1:30 -3:00 PM: Lunch, Work and/or relax on your own. From 3:00 – 5:00 PM: Afternoon session. **We'll then gather to go to beach for a "baptism" in the waters of the Aegean Sea and our own infinite consciousness.** Then 5:00 – 6:30 PM: Rest and/or on your own. We'll have an assignment: Look for dream amulets and altar objects. At 6:30 PM: Optional: sunset and/or informal dinner.

Day 4 – Oct 17 (b/-/-) Earth: the Divine Mother

Start today at 9:00 – 10:00 AM: Breakfast, then 10:00 – 10:30 AM: Tai Chi, and from 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM: Morning session – **Demeter, The Divine Mother, The Earth Element, The Nurturer & Healer.** There will be a Materials demonstration and Assignment: Honoring nature – painting the earth. Then from 1:30- 5:30 PM: Lunch & rest on your own. From 12:30 – 7:00 PM: **Excursion available around the island:** Fira, the museum, Ancient Thira or Megalohori/Pyrgo Akrotiri (Scenic Ancient Dorian Ruins) or another site. Bring small sketchbook & pencils/watercolors OR option to rest and work on your own on your terrace. From 7:30 – 8:30PM Evening session: Discussion of the day.

Day 5 – Oct 18 (b/-/-) Sky: Light & Shadow

We'll start the day at 9:00 – 10:00 AM: Breakfast, then 10:00 – 10:30 AM: Tai Chi, and from 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM: Morning session – **Hestia, The Meditative Goddess and the Goddess Of The Inner Temple and Apollo the God of Light and Clarity.** Today will be a Day of Silence. We'll see the world as a reflection of light – perceiving light and shadow. Lecture & demo. Today's assignment: 3 paintings from 3 different times of day. Demo: how to create luminosity and atmospheric perspective. From 1:30 – 5:30 PM: Lunch, Work and/or beach on your own. Then from 5:00 – 7:00 PM: **Athena the Goddess of Wisdom: Light As Energy And Luminosity.** Evening Session with artwork for group sharing and discussion. Then at 7:30 PM: Informal dinner.

Day 6 – Oct 19 (b/-/-) Fertility: Exploring Color

We'll start 9:00 – 10:00 AM: Breakfast, followed by 10:00 – 10:30 AM: Tai Chi, and from 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM: Morning session – **Hera, The Queen Of Heaven and Zeus, the powerful Creative Energy of the Universe.** Color Demo: complementary colors and exaggerated color. Our assignment: 2 paintings one with complementary colors, one with exaggerated color. *Afternoon time to be announced: **Boat Trip to Volcano or Therassia** – Bring journals/pencils or watercolors, sturdy shoes, jacket and/or windbreaker. Early Dinner at Ammoudi Port after boat trip. Evening session: Meet in Seminar room to share artwork after dinner.

Day 7 – Oct 20 (b/-/-) Fire: Inner Radiance

Start the day at 9:00 – 10:00 AM: Breakfast, then 10:00 – 10:30 AM: Tai Chi, and from 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM: Morning session – **Aphrodite: The Creative & Alchemical Goddess, The Goddess Of Transformation, Radiance & Light Within.** Our Assignment: Paint your inner radiance. Then from 1:30 – 5:00 PM: Lunch & Rest on your own. From 5:00 – 6:30 PM: **Artemis: The Wild Woman and the Goddess of the Moon Unleashing the Wild Woman Within.** We'll end the day at 6:30 PM – 8:00 PM: Evening session – Fire Ceremony. Farewell dinner – Dancing on tables optional!

Day 8 – Oct 21 (b/-/-) Athens & Home

We say our last goodbyes, hugs and kisses as we prepare to take our new dream of creativity back to our lives! Feel free to stay longer in Santorini with Linda to continue painting and relaxing.

Days 9-10 – Oct 22 -23 (b/-/-) Can't Leave?
