**Included**

Total costs for this photo journey for 4 nights and 3 days at our beach house are as follows:

**Single room:** \$615.00 USD per person single occupancy  
**Double room:** \$545.00 USD per person double occupancy  
**A bed in the TV room:** \$465.00 USD per person  
**A couch in the common room:** \$395.00 USD per person

If all spaces in the house fill you can stay at the Inn at Manzanita where rooms average around \$160-170.00 USD per night (503-368-6754). If you decide to stay at the inn your workshop cost would be \$385.00. The inn is one mile from our house on the beach.

There are 4 nights residency at our home in Manzanita unless the house is full and you are staying at the Inn. There are certain meals included in this journey and they are noted next to each day on the trip itinerary below in parentheses (4 breakfasts and snacks). All lectures and photography teachings from Catherine are included. Also included are all spiritual teachings, exercises, ceremonies, teachings during day trips to multiple photographic locations, daily photography group discussions, reviews and assignments.

**Not-Included**

We are not responsible for your round trip flight from your home to Portland, OR. Also not included are: meals not indicated in the itinerary, items of a personal nature such as, gifts, souvenir shopping, laundry services, beverages, toll calls, excess baggage, medical costs, the costs of hospitalization and evacuation from remote areas, travel insurance and additional expenses arising from the delay or extension of a trip due to weather, political disputes, sickness, failure of transportation, or other causes beyond our control. Other non-included items would be: other activities and tours not-included in our package and your transportation to and from the Portland, OR airport.

**Payment**

A \$150.00 dollar deposit per person, which secures your place on the journey, is preferably due by **March 1st, 2010**. The remaining payment in full is due by **May 1st, 2012**. **All payments are by Visa or MasterCard, PayPal, money order or cashier's check, made out to "Journeys of the Spirit®"** Unfortunately, no personal checks can be accepted. All payments must be received in the office a minimum of one week **before** the date of trip departure. We cannot make exceptions to this policy.

**Cancellation and Refunds**

A deposit of \$150.00 USD along with a completed registration form must be submitted to reserve your space. Final payment is due: May 1st, 2012. Any cancellation made in writing between: March 1st, 2012 and April 1st, 2012 will result in a cancellation fee of \$150.00 USD. Any

cancellation made between: April 1st, 2012 and the trip departure will result in a total loss of your funds unless we can find someone to take your place. If we can find someone to replace you, we will refund your balance minus your deposit (\$150.00 USD) which is non-refundable. We reserve the right to cancel the trip if it is not meeting the trip minimum. Trip cancellation insurance is always recommended when making travel plans. You can use our suggested [travel insurance company](#) online and choose from several policy options. Any refund requests must be made in writing to Journeys of the Spirit® within 30 days of the return date. ## **Daily Schedule**

### **Day 1 – Weds June 6th (-/-/s)**

Arrival at the Oceanfront Manzanita Beach House at 7:00 pm. Time to meet everyone, get accustomed to our fantastic beach house, and settle in to your room for the night! We'll go over the general structure for our next days together, talk about your personal workshop goals and get to know each other before our first full day begins on Friday. Tea, coffee and some small snacks will be available. Although dinner is not provided – there are many wonderful places in town for you to eat before you arrive at the beach house. We will provide you with a list of restaurants once you register for the workshop.

A seven mile long sandy beach, Manzanita beach stretches from Neahkahnie Mountain to the Nehalem River jetty. From our house, it is a 10 minute walk down the beach to the small, friendly town of Manzanita. This not overly touristy town has just the right mix of retail shops, coffee shops, bookstore's, restaurants and great grocery stores.

Our house is at the center of a natural paradise that includes hiking trails through old growth forests with incredible ocean vistas, miles of bike paths in Nehalem Bay State Park, surfing at Oswald State Park, fishing in Nehalem River, and crabbing in Nehalem Bay. Golfers will enjoy Manzanita's beautiful and challenging nine hole course. Shoppers can spend time in the art galleries of nearby Cannon Beach or the antique shops of even closer Nehalem and Wheeler. The front lawn of our house is a perfect place to relax during the day or to enjoy barbecuing while watching amazing sunsets. On stormy days, curl up with a book in front of the fire.

### **Days 2-4 June 7-9th (b/-/-)**

We'll spend the next 3 days exploring the coastal area near the beach house. Each morning we'll start our day with breakfast at the house and head out for our morning photo excursion – perhaps to Cannon Beach, Manzanita beach, Neahkahnie Mountain, etc. Yummy lunches at [quaint local restaurants](#) will follow and the rest of the afternoon will be open for you to continue your photography work, take a long walk or take some time for yourself in town. Our evenings will be spent gathering together at the Beach House to discuss our day, download our work to the computer and sharing your work with each other. Then we'll head into town for dinner each evening. There is no definite schedule for these days, only a basic outline that may be changed as I work with the energy present in the moment.

### **Day 5 – Sunday June 10th (b/-/-)**

We wrap up the workshop at noon on Sunday. Breakfast in the morning will be followed by a short gathering – then lot's of hugs and sweet good-bye's. We leave Oregon renewed, refreshed and excited about what we have created and the creative process that will follow!
